



The training sessions will be held in Downtown Louisville and/or West End Louisville, Monday through Friday, from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM. Training to include experienced instructors providing hands-on immersive training, networking opportunities with Louisville Companies and all Certification Exams paid for during the program. There will also include one on one support with resume writing and interview skills and employment opportunities w/local corporations and companies.

Participants must be 18 years of age, or older, and pre-work must be completed prior to the start of the course. Orientation and interview must be completed as part of the application process. Available Orientation Dates Include: Tuesday, December 10th, 2024 – 4:30PM, Thursday, December 12th, 2024 – 4:30 PM. Monday, December 16th, 2024 – 11:30 AM and Wednesday, December 18th, 2024 – 4:30 PM. All Orientations will be located at 1219 W. Jefferson Street Suite 206, Louisville KY 40203. Classes are in person with a strict attendance policy. Eligibility criteria include Louisville residents age 18 or older who want to start a career in IT Support regardless of previous tech experience. Priority participation will be given to low-income residents from low-income zip codes in Jefferson County which especially include 40202, 40203, 40208, 40209, 40210, 40211, 40212, 40215, and 40216 as well as portions of 40213, 40218, and 40219.

Once the application is filled out, the participant will be notified what the next steps will be. 

## **Healthy Recipes**

### Canned Sardine Pasta Dinner

**Serves:** 4-5 **Est. cost:** \$10.00

Est. cost per serving: \$1.70

#### **Ingredients:**

- 1 each 4oz can of sardines
- 2 tbsp cooking oil (e.g. olive oil, canola oil, etc.)
- 2-3 cloves garlic, chopped
- 1 each onion chopped
- 1-2 stalks celery, chopped
- 1 tbsp oregano, fresh or dried
- ½ lemon, juiced
- salt & pepper to taste
- 1 box pasta, cooked

Optional: parmesan cheese





**Equipment:** Can opener, knife, clean / sanitized cutting surface, sauté pan, pot for cooking pasta

#### Directions:

- 1. Cook pasta according to box directions and set aside.
- 2. Cut sardines in half, remove any bones and create chunks of meat. Discard bones.
- 3. In a sauté pan, warm oil over medium heat. Add onions, celery, garlic, and a pinch of salt. Sauté 3-5 minutes or until translucent.
- 4. Add sardines, oregano, and lemon juice and cook until the onions are golden brown.
- 5. Taste and adjust seasonings with salt, pepper, or more lemon.
- 6. Add to fresh cooked pasta and serve with optional parmesan cheese for garnish.
